I realise that's a matter for the courts. I also want to make clear that I am not proposing clemency or parole for Mr Loeb. He is not asking for mercy - he is seeking justice.

Mr Loeb claims rather convincingly (with documents to back him up) that his conviction was based on the organized perjured testimony of several witnesses. I would like to see his claims thoroughly investigated, or be given some reason why they should not be investigated.
